## **GET DESIGNING**

Create your own piece of outdoor sculpture/ art. Look around you to take inspiration for your own piece of outdoor sculpture/ art. Draw a design of your piece and then make it using natural materials.

## **GET RESEARCHING**

Choose one of the sculptures that you have visited. What can you find out about the artist? What was their inspiration for this piece of sculpture?

## **GET WRITING**

Create a story involving your chosen sculpture/ piece of art. How are the main characters connected to the sculpture/art?

## **GET MAKING MUSIC**

Using only natural materials can you make a musical instrument and compose a piece of music to represent nature?

## **GET EARNING HOUSE POINTS**

Create a film based on the 'community'. Record it on any device and save it onto a USB. Enter this in the Priory Oscars and you will earn 20 HPs for entering, 60 for winning a prize or 100HPs for being voted the best overall film. You can work with friends and family to create and edit the film.
